Manure Plan Workshops

ISU Extension will be conducting a series of workshops to assist livestock producers in updating their manure nutrient management plans and meeting annual submission deadlines as required by the Department of Natural Resources. About eight percent of the producers with manure plans on file will be required to submit revised manure plans each month.

Workshops are scheduled in the following counties:

September 11, 2003 – Hamilton County – Webster City at the Extension Office, (515) 832-9597

September 12, 2003 – Greene County – Jefferson at the Extension Office, (515) 386-2138

October 17, 2003 – Jasper County – Newton at the Extension Office, (641) 792-6433

November 14, 2003 – Boone County – Boone at the Extension Office, (515) 432-3882

December 5, 2003 – Story County – Nevada at the Extension Office, (515) 382-6551

The workshops will be conducted by Kapil Arora, Area Agricultural Engineer for ISU Extension. The program will consist of a short overview of the changes in the laws and the forms. Producers will then be able to revise their own plan with assistance from Kapil Arora. Pre-registration is required as seating is limited. Call your county extension office to reserve a spot. A fee of \$35 per person applies for plan development and copying costs. Bring your current manure plan, manure agreements, manure sample analysis, plat maps and FSA maps of new fields that you may have added and a calculator. All appropriate DNR forms will be provided in the workshop. If you have questions, please call any of the above extension offices.
